Uniform Dress Code 07-08

Item	Girls	Boys	Colors
Tops	Blouse, shirt with collar or turtleneck.	Dress shirt, polo or oxford shirt with collar or turtleneck.	White or any shade of blue—solid colors only.
Sweaters	Sweaters or sweatshirts may be worn OVER shirts with collars (no hoods)	Sweaters or sweatshirts may be worn OVER shirts with collars (no hoods)	White or any shade of blue—solid colors only. No stripes, decorations or wording.
Bottoms	Knee length skirts, slacks, capri pants or knee length shorts. Plain-no chains, decorations, etc.	Pants, knee length shorts. Plain-no chains, decorations, etc	Navy blue, khaki, or black—solid color NO DENIM
Belts	If there are belt loops, a belt must be worn. (no large belt buckles)	If there are belt loops, a belt must be worn. (no large belt buckles)	Black or brown
Shoes	Shoes with enclosed toes and heels. Athletic gym shoes with matching shoestrings (tied in a bow). No wheels!	Shoes with enclosed toes and heels. Athletic gym shoes with matching shoestrings (tied in a bow). No wheels!	

Tops may be either tucked in or worn out if at least three inches below the waist, hemmed, and no longer than mid-thigh. T-shirts, under shirts, tops worn under the uniform shirts must be tucked in and in uniform colors only (blue or white). No low cut tops. Outer shirts must be no lower than 2 inches from the neck. All bottoms must be worn at or above the hip bone and should fit appropriately. Knee length shorts may be worn from **April 1st through October 15th**. Shoe strings must always be a matched pair and must be tied appropriately at all times. Sandals may be worn from April 1st through October 15th. Flip flops are strongly discouraged for safety reasons

The administration reserves the right to make final judgment concerning attire and appearance. Those out of dress code will call home to request a change of clothes.
Repeated offences will be considered insubordination with consequences.
