

2007-08 Uniform Info to Parents

On the page attached, you will find the clothing requirements.

Uniforms must be worn on the first day of school, August 14th. Attached to this first bulletin is a calendar identifying any “Non-Uniform Days”. Along with this, students may be in non-uniform for all Awards Day ceremonies – provided they are in dress-up clothing --- dresses for girls / suits or shirts w/ ties for boys. No casual wear and no denim is allowed on Awards Days.

Students who fail to follow the guidelines will be subjected to these consequences:

First Dress Code Violation	Parent Called & Delivers Correct Clothing
Second Dress Code Violation	Parent Called & Delivers Correct Clothing & Student Serves ONE After School Detention
Third Dress Code Violation	Parent Called & Delivers Correct Clothing & Student Serves TWO After School Detentions
Fourth Dress Code Violation	Parent Called & Delivers Correct Clothing & Parent Meets with Principal & Student Serves THREE After School Detentions
Fifth Dress Code Violation	Parent Called & Delivers Correct Clothing & Parent Meets with Principal & Student Serves FOUR After School Detentions

At any time during this, the Social Worker or the Family and Community Services Specialist may also meet with the families.

Students who transfer into Wilson after the first week of school will have TWO (2) weeks to comply.

Eventually, “loaner” uniforms may be available. After the first year, we will have a “used uniform sale.”

Please realize that local stores have ALREADY ordered their uniforms for August sales. Please shop early or get on the internet to purchase these. Shop yard sales over the summer and visit used clothing stores. All families currently enrolled MUST have uniforms the first day of school.

PANTS	navy or khaki	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> solid colored no cargo pants or pants with multiple large pockets, no mesh, nylon, bikers, sweatpants 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> no oversized clothing allowed if it has belt loops, must have belt do not cut off belt loops
SKIRTS & JUMPERS	navy or khaki	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> solid colored wear shorts under for gym class if it has belt loops, must have belt / don't cut off 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> no oversized clothing allowed must come to end of fingertips when hands are held down by your sides.
CAPRIS	navy or khaki	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> solid colored if it has belt loops, must have belt / don't cut off no cargo, mesh, nylon, bikers, sweats 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> no oversized clothing allowed permitted ONLY during 1st and 4th quarters
SHORTS, SKORTS, or CULOTTES	navy or khaki	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> solid colored if it has belt loops, must have belt / don't cut off no oversized clothing allowed 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> permitted ONLY during 1st and 4th quarters must come to end of fingertips when hands are held down by your sides.

APPROPRIATE UNIFORM TOPS:

SHIRTS OR BLOUSES	white, yellow, light blue, navy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> solid colored must have sleeves (short, 3/4, or long) must have collars (pointed, polo, Peter Pan, or turtleneck) no tank tops, halters, cropped, mesh, spaghetti straps, or double shirts no hoodies or tie backs shirts must be tucked in (for boys & girls) OR shirt or blouse may be worn out IF it has a straight bottom hem and is no longer than 2" below waist. We will require the shirt to be tucked in if too long. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> may be knit or dress shirt no oversized clothing allowed must be buttoned up to the first button from the top (top button may be unbuttoned) must be free of wording and emblems / decorations / logos no "capped sleeves"
SWEATERS OR SWEATSHIRTS	same colors at tops	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> solid colored cardigan, vest, or pullover (v-neck or crew) no hoodies or kangaroo pouches must have uniform shirt under it 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> no oversized clothing allowed must be free of wording and emblems / decorations / logos may have a zippered front

APPROPRIATE UNIFORM ACCESSORIES:

GYM SHOES	white, black, neutral colors / including laces	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> may be hook & looped fastened may be tied – must be laced tightly non-marking soles (not black) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> shoes with laces must be laced and tied tightly must be worn with socks or hose / tights
DRESS SHOES	white, black, neutral colors / including laces	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> may be hook & loop fastened may be tied – must be laced tightly no slides, flip-flops, high heels 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> must have low heels must be worn with socks or hose / tights
SANDALS	white, black, neutral colors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> must have low heels no slides, flip-flops, high heels 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> must have backs to them must be worn with socks or hose / tights may be worn only 1ST and 4TH quarters
BELTS	black, navy, khaki, burgundy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> solid colored – no prints/ stripes / designs fabric, leather or vinyl (no rope, sash, or ribbon) no oversized belt buckles / studs / gems, etc 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> must be worn if bottoms have belt loops THIS IS FOR BOYS AND GIRLS We understand that some girls' pants come with striped sash belts but these are not allowed.
TIES		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> although NOT REQUIRED, ties are acceptable accessories to their uniforms 	
Girls-SOCKS or TIGHTS	any uniform color	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> solid colored – no prints/ stripes / designs only in uniform colors: white, light yellow, light blue, or navy 	
Boys – SOCKS	any uniform or neutral color (tan/grey)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> solid colored – no prints/ stripes / designs showing. We understand that many boys' socks come in solid with a striped top. Striped tops cannot show under their uniform or when they wear shorts. 	
WILSON WEAR		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> White polos with Wilson Primary Logo are appropriate shirts for any time. Wilson Sweatshirts are only allowed on certain days. Watch home bulletins.
